- o strong focus on math, and ability to incorporate place-based learning and First Peoples' Indigenous Worldviews and Perspectives within math planning;
- o strong interpersonal, communication, and collaborative skills to communicate with students, staff, and parents in a team oriented approach to teaching and learning;
- o strong formative assessment practices;
- o ability to communicate student learning through the use of digital portfolio assessment and three way conferencing;
- o experience with RTI (Response to Intervention) systems;
- o ability to integrate technology to enhance student learning;
- o strong interest in innovation and inquiry; and
